A public hearing will be conducted for informing customers and soliciting public input, written or oral, regarding the ***Master Plan Capital Projects*** Project Needs Assessment (PNA) and Environmental Assessment (EA). The PNA is a report detailing the project as proposed, including project necessity, alternatives, and components. The PNA also describes how the project is being funded. The reports are being submitted to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to qualify Snake River Water District for a State Revolving Fund Loan.

Based on a 10-year Master Plan created by AE2S our engineering firm, SRWD has several projects needed to address aging infrastructure. Their hydraulic model evaluated system performance and risks, then recommended capital improvements to the water system such as a new storage tank for increased fire flow, as well as replacement of aging distribution system pipelines, hydrants, and pumps.

The estimated total cost of the projects is \$13,815,541.
